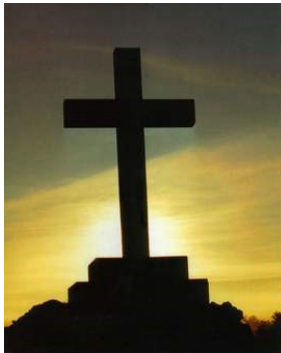


## CHURCHES TOGETHER IN WELLING
